

Three historic Barnstaple Schools have come together into this new building:-

- The oldest of them is the Parish Church Junior Girls' School, founded by Alice Horwood in 1659 - only the Grammar School in Barnstaple has a longer history.
- 2. The Bluecoat School was founded in 1710 and was first sited over the North Gate.
- 3. Pilton School was founded in 1815 and has always stood in the church precincts.

Each School has given much to the citizens of this ancient Borough and has had its separate history and customs. Yet, to-day, under a new Board of Managers and a new Headmaster, each School sinks its individual identity so that a new and better Church School may emerge. Built on the sure foundations of the past, holding faith in God as central to its life, the Bluecoat School, Pilton, looks forward with confidence.
